With reference to your application on the subject cited above, I am directed to convey the approval for Extension of General Affiliation as per details given below.

**Category:** Extension of General Affiliation  
**Period of Extension of:** 01.04.2021 to 31.03.2025

In view of current COVID-19 pandemic which has most severely affected the normal functioning of schools in the country, however, the effort is continuing to provide extension of affiliation so as to avoid any difficulty for the purpose of admitting /registering/withdrawing /substitution of various safety certificates from appropriate State authorities.

Therefore, the competent authority of the Board after due consideration has accorded approval for extension of Affiliation based on satisfactory response by school as online application for a further period of 5 years subject to fulfilment of following conditions:

1. The school will follow the **RTE Act, 2009** and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time.
2. The School is required to apply on online for further extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws, 2018.
3. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned as mentioned in certificate as per Appendix III issued by District Education Officer (DEO) /equivalent officer.
4. The school should ensure the strong governance and management of its activities in way of comprehensive and quantifiable planning in way of curriculum planning, infrastructure, resources, physical education, staff development and other co-curricular areas.
5. An school should also through the provision of **Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and keep a copy** thereof of its reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE website i.e. <http://cbseacademic.nic.in> & <http://cbse.nic.in> for updates. The School is requested to visit all updates on these CBSE websites regularly.
6. The school will strictly adhere to all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting and Transportation, etc. Further school will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls respectively in proportion to the number of students. The school will ensure that Fire, Building, health and sanitation and safe drinking water certificates are renewed from time to time, as per norms.
7. **Admission to the school** is to be restricted as per relevant rules of Examination Bye-laws and rule 2.4.5, 2.6.5, 7.1, 7.2, 8.4.3, 9.4.1.9 & other relevant rules of Affiliation bye laws.
8. The school is required to follow rule No. 2.4.7 and 2.4.8 of Affiliation Bye Laws regarding Books and Quality of Education.
9. The number of seats as may be restricted as per the Appendix V of the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board. For increase in number of sections, the School shall apply online to the Board as per rule 15.7 of Affiliation Bye laws.
10. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust name, which liability related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. The school shall also be liable to bear all legal charges incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances.
11. The school should adhere to promote conservation of environment on their campus through rain water harvesting, segregation of waste in recycle, recycling of organic waste, proper disposal of waste including electronic waste, use of energy saving and energy efficient electrical equipment, greening of campus, use of solar energy, education and awareness amongst children on environmental conservation and cleanliness etc.
12. Teachers shall submit their information through Online Affiliated School Information System (OASIS) as per details given in circular no. [affiliation-001/2018 dated 24.04.2018](#). Link for OASIS is available on Board's website [www.cbse.nic.in](#)
13. The teacher:Student/teacher ratio of 1:15 as well as student:teacher ratio of 10:1 is to be maintained to teach various subjects and schools shall employ qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
14. Private affiliated school shall sponsor regularly its bonafide and eligible students in Sports Class X and Class XII examinations from the year approved while granting affiliation/up-gradation regularly without break or inform with nearest threat in accordance to the school law, in compliance of the conditions.
15. Faculty of teaching profession in the school provides in the context of providing coaching to the students for various examinations as per directed by the Board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
16. The Headmaster/Principal of the school shall be jointly responsible for the authenticity of the certificate/ documents submitted by the school to the Board.
17. School fees rules to be followed to be by the school as mentioned above for drawing specific attention at the school authorities. The 02 nos. authorities are required to sign and themselves with all the rules contained in Affiliation & Examination Bye-Laws and certificate/ documents submitted to the Board from time to time. Any laxity in following rules/instructions of the Board will lead to action against school as per clause 12 of Affiliation Bye-laws 2018.
18. The school should submit information / documents / data submitted shall be of school and in case, if found otherwise the school shall be liable as per Affiliation Bye laws 2018.
19. The school shall be responsible for submission of any pending compliance, copy of show cause / legal notice / complaint and for submission of data/documents sought by the Board. The extension of 05 years shall be from the date of cessation of previous period of affiliation.
20. The school is required to remain pending fee, if any.
21. The extension of affiliation is being granted as one time measure. However, the cases where the State Court/Magistrate has decreed/declared or pronounced / issued orders any pending against the school, the Board will take appropriate decision which matter.
22. The school shall remain all mandatory safety certificate i.e. safe drinking water & health and hygiene certificate, fire safety certificate and building safety certificate from appropriate Govt. authorities from time to time.
23. The school shall also maintain record of certificate, compliance, data and other necessary information and shall be fully responsible to produce all such records before Board and appropriate Government Authorities when asked for, along with necessary action plan in terms as per Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board. The school shall also be liable for action by the appropriate Govt. in case of violation / non-compliance of the concerned Govt. norms.
24. The school shall be subject to central inspection of school as per clause 11.2 and 11.4 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
